Description	The Biblioteca Nacional de España (BNE) is the national library of Spain and is located in Madrid. It was founded in 1712 by King Philip V, making it one of the oldest national libraries in the world. The library's collection contains over 30 million items, including books, manuscripts, maps, prints, photographs, musical scores, sound recordings and other materials. The BNE's collections are divided into different categories, such as fine arts, cartography and



	geography, music and more. The library also has a digital collection called Biblioteca Digital Hispánica, which provides free access to thousands of digitised documents.
